The Last Will and Testament of Rebecca Lattimer D. S.

In the name of God Amen I Rebecca Lattimer (wife of William Lattimer of Warren County & State of Georgia) do by virtue of Marriages Contract entered into & duly executed before my late husband with my said husband make and ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner and form following First and primarily I commit my soul into the Hands of Almighty God who gave it and touching those worldly goods with which I have been as God to bless me I dispose of them as follows

Imparting & I give & bequeath to my son Charles Lattimer four hundred acres of the Land of which he & my trustee purchase of the Estate of Isaac Tucker being the Land on which I now live to be land of in said manner as he may choose so as to include the whole or any part of the buildings on the said Land to him or his forever also his choice of any one of my Negroes I make the foregoing bequest to my son Charles in consideration of his particular attention to me and his care of the family

Then the balance of my Land not herein before devised I give & bequeath to be equally divided between my two sons James Lattimer & Horace Augustus Lattimer to them and their heirs forever

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Maria Taylor my Negro boy Cato son of Hannah

Then the residue of my Estate of whatever it may consist to be equally divided between my five sons William Marshall Lattimer Charles Lattimer Samuel Marcus Lattimer James Lattimer and Horace Augustus Lattimer Item It is my Will & desire that my son Charles Lattimer shall retain the life interest and have the entire control of all my property until the whole amount of the money for the Land which he bought as my trustee of foregoing shall be paid he my said son Charles to support the family which may remain with him from the proceeds of the said property

Lastly I fully constitute appoint & ordain my son Charles Lattimer sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament In testimony of the foregoing I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 15th day of August in the year of our Lord 1850
