Item - my will and desire is that my two daughters Polly Robbins and Julian Robbins to have a tract of land containing two hundred two and a half acre situated lying and being in the 7th district in the County of Fayette No 46 drawn by my late Grand being date the 28 of August 1848 and to be equally divided between Polly Robbins and Julian Robbins hereinafter. also four cows and calves and a horse and their increase to Polly Robbins also one fether bed and furniture and one clock.

My will and desire is for Julian Robbins to have two cows and calves and two horses and their increase, one fether bed and furniture and for Polly Robbins to have the first calf that my man does and Julian to have the second.

Item - My will and desire is for my daughter Susan Robbins to have a cream cutting man and eight head of cattle and their increase, also sixteen head of hogs. Also one fether bed and furniture and all the things my house furniture.

Item - My will and desire is for John Slone to have a cow and calf and their increase and one fether bed and furniture.

Item - My will and desire is for my son Nicholas Slone to have one dollar.

Item - My will and desire is for my loving son John Slone to have one dollar.
