Principally and first of all, I give & recommend my soul to God who gave it, and for my Body, I recommend to the Earth: to be buried in a Christian like manner, at the discretion of my Executors; nothing doubting, at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same, by the Almighty power of God. And as touching such worldly Estate wherewith I am blessed with God's blessing with, in this life, I give, devise & dispose of in the following manner and form, that is to say I give and bequeath to my beloved son John Bush, One Boy's Silver Table Spoon, said a Boy's Silver Tea, Spoon.

Item. I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Jane Richardson One Boy's Silver Table Spoon, and One Boy's Tea Spoon, the same to be brought out of my estate.

Item. I leave the residue of all my estate, both Real and Personal, to my beloved wife Elizabeth Bush, her my hee Heirs at law, or the next of kin, and at her death, to be equally divided between my three Children Elizabeth, a Martha, and John. And it is the sense of my wife & I have set her before me as a reward, being a poor woman, that my Executors should keep my children together, but further of said estate should be before they marry or come of age, the surviving or wid or said children either Elizabeth or Martha, to take the whole.

I have constituted make and made my beloved wife Elizabeth Bush, my son John Bush, and son William Bush my only and able of this my Last Will & Testament, And I do hereby utterly disavow, revoke and annul, all and every other former Testaments, Wills, and

Legacies, Bequests and Executors, by me in any way before this time, by me made, Willed and Legated, Altered, Repealing and Confirming this and no other to be my Last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have made and signed my hand and affix my seal, the day and year above written.
