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Warren County, Georgia, You Larken Wilcher do swear that you signed Alfred Walden's name to the above instrument of writing at his request and in his presence and in his presence and that it was sealed and published as his last will and Testament at his request and at the time thereof he was in your opinion and belief of sound and disposing mind and memory and that did it freely without compulsion - and that Alfred Walden was a subscribing witness to said Will with yourself and that you both subscribed the same at the request of the said Testator in his presence and in the presence of each other so help you God

I give my soul to God that gave it and my body to decent burial
Item 2nd

It is my desire that all my just debts be immediately paid as there is no cause for delay of the same -
Item 3rd

I give to my son James Norris one brown grey Horse Sealant -
Item 4th

I give to my son Solomon Norris one Grey Colt. Hocking Clay
Item 5th

I give to my son John Norris one horse colt about six months old
Item 6th

I give to my beloved Susan Norris all of my lands and negroes and plantation and farming tools and horses that I have not disposed of in the above items to my sons and all of my cattle and pigs corn and fodder household and kitchen

207th

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I do constitute my property of every kind and description in and about my premises to have and to hold during her lifetime or widowhood in order to raise and educate my children and at her death or marriage ~~to divide~~ my property to be equally divided between all of my children James Norris Leahy Norris Charity Norris now Charity James, Solomon Norris Mary Norris John Norris Nancy Norris Phoebe and Phoebe about equal

Item 7th

I do constitute my wife Susan Norris executrix and my son James Norris executor of this my will

I do constitute this my last will revoking any or all wills heretofore by me made -
