

The last will & Testament of Wm. B. Dennis, decd.

Warren County, Georgia Wills 1829-1852

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Georgia, Warren County. } Dennis' Nuncupative will,
Made by him in his last sickness at his usual place of abode, at the house of C. Dennis, in the County and State aforesaid, two or three days before his death, who departed this life on the fifteenth of October, eighteen hundred and thirty six. His Will and pleasure was that his brother Richmond A. Dennis, have his young bay horse and Rifle Gun
And. His Will and pleasure was that his land be sold and the money equally divided between all his brothers and sisters.

And. We have no doubt from what he said that his father C. Dennis be his Executor.

In testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands this 10th day of November 1836.
