I give and bequeath to my brother Bede Proctor all of my property both real and personal, after the payment of my just debts - And I further appoint my brother Bede Proctor Executor to this my last Will and testament - In witness whereof I have this day set my hand and seal this the sixth day of March, Eighteen hundred and forty three. (1843)
