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Warren County, Georgia, William Proctor, being of sound and memory do make and ordain this my last will and Testament utterly revoking all other Wills by me made.

I give and bequeath to my brother Beder Proctor all of my property both real and personal, after the payment of my just debts - And I further appoint my brother Beder Proctor Executor to this my last Will and testament - In witness whereof I have this day set my hand and seal this the sixth day of March, Eighteen hundred and forty three. (1843)
