

In the name of God, Amen— I, Amos Wright Senr of the State of Georgia, and Warren County, considering the uncertainty of this mortal life, and being of sound and perfect mind and memory, (blessed be Almighty God for the same), do make and publish this my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following, (that is to say), First, I commend my soul to Almighty God, and desire that my body may be decently buried. Secondly, I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife, Rachel Wright, all my estate in Warren County, both Real and Personal, during her life or widow-hood; if my Wife marry, it is my will and desire that all my estate, in the County above mentioned (except my Land) be immediately divided among those my children mentioned in this Will, (to wit) Eliza, Bazil, Lewis, Joseph, & Amos, James, Lucy, Cloe, and Drucilla, except one third, or a Childs part, which my Wife may choose to take— Thirdly, I give and bequeath all my Land in Warren County, unto my sons (Bazil, Joseph, & Amos, & James, which is to be equally divided among them, at the death of my Wife, and not before— Fourthly, I give and bequeath unto my grandson John I reserve enough to pay him her ever bound schooling, and the sum of one hundred dollars; which is to be paid out of my estate— Fifthly, It is my will and desire, that my Land in Warren County, at my death, shall be sold for the benefit of all my children, except my son John— & to this, I give and bequeath unto my son John the sum of One Hundred Dollars.

And further, It is my will and desire, that my grandson Joseph Ryan, shall have the hundred dollars given to him in this Will, when he comes of age by Law.

I, Amos Wright Senr, do hereby declare and acknowledge this to be my last Will and Testament, revoking all former Will and Obligations whatsoever. In witness whereof,
