Washington County, In the name of God Amen

I Andrew J. Sipkins of the County and State aforesaid being engaged in the service of my Country, knowing that life is uncertain that I may be called home in a short time, desiring to arrange my worldly affairs while I have time and opportunity do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament in the following manner to

Item 1^o I leave unto my beloved mother Mary J. Sipkins during the term of her natural life all my property both real and personal and at her death it is my will and I do hereby direct that the whole of my said property be equally divided between my Brother and Sister that may be living at the time of my death and the children of those of them that may be dead at the time (except the children of my deceased Sister Mary Flicker who I do not intend to be benefited out of my estate) though it is not for the want of affording but that they are already well provided for

Item 2^o I do hereby nominate and appoint my Brother Joseph W. Sipkins Executor of this my last Will and Testament, and I do hereby revoke all former Wills by me heretofore made
