My Soul I trust shall return to rest with God, who gave it, as I hope for salvation through the merits and atonement of the blessed SOTD and Saviour **JESUS CHRIST**

Second, I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without delay by my Executors hereinafter named and appointed

Thirdly, I give bequeath and devise to Anna E Braswell daughter of my beloved Niece Jane Braswell one Bed and furniture to her the said Anna E Braswell forever

Fourthly— I give bequeath and devise to my beloved Niece Jane Bridges Wife of Alexander Bridges, and my beloved Brother Washington H Peacock and their heirs all the balance of my personal estate, Consisting of Horses Mules Cattle Hogs Wagons Carbs plantation tools farming utensils Household and Kitchen furniture Clock and other things, that hath not been previously mentioned, to them the said Nancy Bridges, and Washington H Peacock and their heirs forever

Fifthly, I hereby constitute and appoint my friend Alexander Bridges, Executor of this my last Will and Testament this August 30th 1866.
