

Archibald C. Ruggan

Cause & Ruggan of the County and State aforesaid knowing that it is appointed for all men to die and that desiring to make a disposition of the worldly goods with which it has pleased God to bless me - I do hereby make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following to wit,
 First - It is my will and desire that I be buried in a decent and Christian like manner

Second - It is my will and desire that all my just debts be paid by my Executor as soon after my death as circumstances will admit

Third - My will and desire is that all my property both real and personal be equally divided between my wife, Nancy R. Ruggan and all my children (both those born unto me by my former wife Elizabeth Ann Ruggan and those born unto me by my present wife Nancy R. Ruggan) share and share alike, with the exception mentioned in the fourth item of this my last Will and Testament concerning my wife the said Nancy R. Ruggan

Fourthly - Over and above an equal share in my personal estate I give and bequeath in trust, during her natural life only, unto my wife the said Nancy R. Ruggan, my household and to her furniture also my horse (her choice) and buggy and a reasonable years support of provisions; and I also give and bequeath unto her in trust during her natural life only, about three hundred and seventy acres land, being all the lands I formerly bought from Archibald Lane and the same on which I now reside. This land I give unto my wife as her share of my real estate, and it is in lieu of dower or any other interest in my real estate; all the property given to my wife, the said Nancy R. Ruggan in this my last Will and Testament is given in trust only, during her natural life, and at her death is to be divided amongst her children by me.

Fifthly - As before stated, I desire that all my children shall share alike in my estate; but my will and desire is that the distribution share falling to each of my daughters shall be settled upon that daughter and the heirs of her body; therefore any property real or personal constituting the distributive share of any one of my daughters is hereby given to my son Dry W. Ruggan, in trust for said daughter during her natural life and at her death is to be divided amongst her children or if she should die childless, then the property is to return and be divided amongst all my children, but should any one of my daughters having attained majority die childless leaving a will such will may be taken

Sixth - I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my son Dry W. Ruggan Executor of this my last Will and Testament Signed this October 26th 1871
 and witnessed by

2nd I desire that all my just debts be paid without delay
by executors hereinafter named and appointed
3rd I desire that my husband Elijah Eastwood have the use of
my plantation the present year 1877 for his own proper use con-
sent and behoof forever with full power to dispose of in his will
as he may deem proper

4th My Son that Judge J. F. Youngblood now holds in trust for
me & what sold and the proceeds of the same to be applied to the
purpose of procuring Miss Sarah Stokes to be placed at my
