and Testament

Item Second - I give and bequeath unto my two Daughters viz Minnie Philips
and Mary Philips all my land one hundred and two acres together with my stock
Cattle and Hogs and Household furniture Notes &c

I Archelus Duggan of the County and State aforesaid being of
sound mind and memory do make and Ordain this my last will and Testament

Item First I wish all my just debts that may be outstanding against
me at the time of my death to be paid as soon as may be convenient

2nd I wish all the property that may remain over and above my
just debts to remain in the name of my Wife Permelope A Duggan
during her natural life or widowhood. In Case after her interment
I give and bequeath to her the sum of Twelve hundred Dollars the
residue of my property to be divided equally between her and my
Children

3rd In Case of the said Permelope A Duggan being a widow under
any of the Children becoming of age, or if any of them should
marry, allowing her the right to give to said Child or children any
amount she may be able to spare, yet not to exceed to any one
greater amount than she will be able to give to each of the other Children

4th I hereby appoint my beloved Brother John A Duggan Executor
to this my last will and Testament
