Item 1. I give devise and bequeath to Mary Sallie Wood, wife of J. S. Wood, my plantation in Washington County, Georgia known as the Hines plantation now rented out to me, containing about 816 acres formerly belonging to my late husband George Hines, with all the improvements and appurtenances, to the said Mary Sallie and to her heirs and assigns forever, in fee simple. I also give to the said Mary Sallie absolutely six (6) shares of the Capital stock of the South Western Rail Road Company of Ga and all dividends due thereon; also any money that may be due me by the firm of J. S. Wood & Son, except that out of this money, I wish one share of the capital stock of the Central Rail Road and Planting Co. of Ga to be bought for Mrs. W. H. Carter.

Item 2. I also give with bequeath to my sister Mrs. Annie Carter wife of W. H. Carter one Silverware Chalice. I wish she not use all of this during her life (when she is at home) but my will is that the balance shall belong to my said sister, to dispose of as she sees fit.

Item 3. I also give and bequeath to my mother Mrs. John Withers and my sisters Mrs. Julia Withers and Mrs. Susan Withers all my household and kitchen furniture, plates and other little objects of the household and kitchen.

Item 4. Out of the rest of my property, I desire all my debts and expenses of administration to be paid and then my will is, that all of the rest and residue of my property real and personal, shall go to and belong absolutely to my three nephews J. A. Brown, Geo A. Brown and John Thomas Brown equally share and share alike.

Item 5. I constitute J. S. Wood of Savannah & J. A. Brown of Sandersville the Executors of this will.
