I Benjamin F Sessions, of the County and State aforesaid do  
make this my last will and testament in manner and form following  
to wit,

First It is my will and desire that my body after my death be buried  
in a decent and Christian like manner, and that my debts be paid as  
early as practicable by my Executor hereafter appointed.

Second, I give and bequeath to my beloved Mother Mary Bishop  
during her natural life all of my property both real and personal at  
her death, the remainder of the same be equally divided among my brother  
then in life, and the children of those of them that may be dead according  
to the rule of Consanguinity, and the laws regulating the distribution  
of intestate estates,

Third—I hereby nominate and appoint my beloved uncle Steven  
E. Lawson Executor to this my last Will and testament this 6<sup>th</sup> day  
of August 1861 Benjamin F Sessions
