 early as practicable by my Executor hereafter appointed.

Second, I give and bequeath to my beloved mother Mary B Sessions
 during her natural life all of my property both real and personal, at
 her death, the remainder of the same be equally divided among my brother
 then in life, and the children of those of them that may be dead accord
 to the rule of Consanguinity, and the laws regulating the distribution
 of intestate estates.

Third - I hereby nominate and appoint my beloved uncle Simon
 & Lawren Executor to this my last Will and testament this 6th day
 of August 1861
