Then I give and bequeath with full power to dispose of the same at any time during her natural life as she may see proper.

Item 7. I now state that after the death of my wife that it is my Will that all my proper heirs shall have an equal share of what then remains.

Item 8. I constitute and appoint my beloved wife Elizabeth Executor to this my last Will and Testament. Also I leave it to her own option whether she chooses an Executor or not or who she chooses. Then March 28th 1843
