I hereby cloath her said trustee by and with her consent to pay or deliver to the one of my Children standing mostly in need, and take his or her receipt for the same, which shall stand as that much of and in his or her proportion of my Estate at a final distribution of the same which I wish and desire to be done as soon as practicable after the death of my beloved Wife and distributed according to law among all my Children or their legal representatives, share and share alike. Lastly, I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my beloved Brother Thomas Jordan and my beloved son Archibald Jordan Executors to this my last Will and Testament

In the name of God Amen,
I Elizabeth Robison of the said State and County, being of sound mind and body, and of an advanced age, knowing that I must shortly depart this frail and transitory life, deem it right and proper, both as respect, my family and myself, that I should a disposition of the property which a kind Providence has blessed do therefore make, this my last will and testament hereby revoking all others heretofore made by me

Item 1st I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christianlike manner suitable to my circumstances and condition in life. My Soul I trust shall return to rest with God who gave it, as I hope for eternal salvation through the merits and atonement of the blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, whose religion I have professed and I humbly trust enjoyed for thirty years

Item 2nd I give and bequeath all my personal Estate to my six Children Robert, William, and Rufus, and Martha, Eliza and Penny to be equally divided among them, I desire that my three Daughters Eliza, Mable, the wife of Mr J Mable, Martha Robison, the wife of James Robison and my daughter

Elizabeth Robison will,

Penny, to have their part of my personal estate for their sole and separate use for and during their natural lives, then to their bodily heirs, free and exempt from the debts and liabilities of their present or future husbands - I appoint my beloved son William A Robison trustee of the property herein given and bequeathed to my two daughters, Penny, and Eliza Sprinkle, the wife of William D Sprinkle, and my son Rufus A Robison trustee of the property herein given and bequeathed to my beloved daughter Martha Robison the wife of James Robison.

Item 3^d - I give and bequeath to my three Daughters Martha Eliza and Penny all my Household and Kitchen Furniture together the Contents of my Smoke or meat House for their sole and separate use.

Item 4th - I desire and Will that the Grave Yard where my beloved Husband and son is buried to be paved in, in a decent and workman like manner out of good and lasting material.

Item 5th - I desire and Will that my aged and faithful servant Penah be permitted to choose her place of Residence among my children, and that each one of my Children give to her ten Dollars 10.00, in cash to be placed in responsible hands and given to her as the necessities and infirmities of her old age requires.

Item 6th - I hereby constitute and appoint my three beloved sons Robert William and Rufus as Executors of my last Will and Testament June 27th 1855 her
