

Francis A. Mills

Georgia September the 29th 1863

Washington County In the name of God Amen

I know all men by these presents, that I Francis A. Mills
of County and State above written, knowing that it is appointed
unto all men once to die, and feeling that I am approaching the
hour of dissolution, yet being of sound mind and disposing memory
do make this my last Will and Testament

Item 1st I Consign my body to the dust from whence it was
taken, and my Soul to God who gave it

Item 2nd After the expenses, incurred by a decent burial
I want all my just debts paid after which I desire

Item 3rd That my only child Susan Mary Mills shall
have all my property consisting of Household and Kitchen
furniture, Money, One head of Cattle and four hundred and
ninety acres of Land lying in Colquitt County Georgia which
Land I desire sold for the benefit of my child, I also desire
her to have all my notes & Acccounts or that they be collected by
my Executor for her benefit, also all other property I may have at
the time of my death

Item 4th It is my will that my child be educated that
my Executor use sufficient amount of my property to give her a
good liberal English education

Item 5th It is my will that if my beloved child die without
issue, that my property in that case be equally divided between
my Brother and Sisters, and that Charles J. Shippell share equally
with them

Item 6th It is my will that Charles J. Shippell set up and
to this my last will and testament, and that he also act as
Guardian for my child Susan Mary Mills in accordance with this
written will.
