Item 2nd I give bequeath and devise to my wife Elphage Harrison

that tract of land lying in the 89th District & 2nd of said county bounded on the north by W. C. Jenkins and Lewis Strawbridge, east by my twin tract of land and land of A. W. J. Wood, on the south by my tract of land designated by me as my Johnson tract on which J. M. Brantley now resides, and on the west by G. J. Youngs land, containing one hundred and sixty three acres more or less, said land designated by me as my cross road place

Item 3rd I give, bequeath and devise to my son John B. Harrison and to the lawful heirs of his body at his death, that tract of land recently bought of J. C. Whitaker, lying in Johnson County Ga on the west side of and bounded on the east by the big Choptank river, containing about three hundred thirty acres more or less. Also that tract of land lying in the 1384th District & 4th Washington County Ga on the east side of and bounded on the west by Little Choptank river and designated by me as my Blombers place containing five hundred acres more or less.

Should my son the said John B. Harrison die, having no lawful issue of his body begotten, then the title to said two tracts of land, is to vest in my brothers and sisters, or if any or all of them should be dead in their lawful issue of their bodies born or begotten.

Item 4th I give grant and devise to my son the said John B. Harrison all my other property both real and personal of every kind and character without entailment, said property to vest absolutely in said John B. Harrison

Item 5th I enjoin upon my son the said John B. Harrison (which however I am assured is not necessary) the duty of properly supporting and maintaining his mother - my wife - in such manner as her circumstances at any time may require.

Item 6th I hereby constitute and appoint my son the said John B. Harrison, executor of this my last will and Testament.
