Washington County } In the name of God Amen.

I Harrel Heriot of said County and State being of advanced age and knowing that I must shortly depart this life deem it right and proper both to respect my family and myself that I should make a disposition of the property with which a kind Providence has blessed me do therefore make this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other testaments made by me.

1st Item - I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner, suitable to my circumstances and conditions in life. My soul I trust shall return to rest with God, who gave it, as I hope for eternal salvation through the merits and utterances of the blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

2^d Item - I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without delay by my Executors hereinafter appointed, as I am unwilling my Creditors should be delayed in their rights.

3^r Item - I give and bequeath and direct to my Son Henry H Heriot one hundred and eight acres of land to be laid off of my land as follows commencing at a Black Gum tree, and runnng a straight line across the East part part of my land as to make the one hundred and eighteen acres, with all the rights members and franchises to said land in anywise appertaining or belonging thereto. Also the said Henry H Heriot is to have the use of my gin packing screw and sugar mill to gin and pack his own Cotton and to make his sumpt free of charge by the said Henry to help keep them in Order.

4th Item - I give bequeath and direct to my minor Children, George J Heriot, Hincklin R Heriot, Clifford A Heriot, Gustave C H Heriot, all the remainder of my Plantation all of my stock including Mares, Horses, cattle, Goats, sheep and all my plantation tools. Bequests to said Children from me and all of my perishable property not mentioned above to keep together for the said Children. Also my beloved Wife Martha J Heriot is to have her support out of the said property, so long as she lives or remains a widow, let herethen or Marry the above property to be equally divided among my above named Children to wit, George J Heriot, Hincklin R Heriot, Clifford A Heriot and Gustave C H Heriot. Also I wish my beloved wife and four children all to remain together in my place. And I appoint my Son Henry J Heriot trustee of the property herein given and bequeathed to my Children.

5th Item - I hereby constitute and appoint my son Henry H Heriot and my worthy friend William E Brown Executors of this my last Will and Testament this December 27th 1869.
