 Item first - It is my Will and desire that my Son Henry Solomon Will move to my place as soon as he can build suitable buildings to live in and live on my place as long as I may live to take care of me in my old age and that he take control of my business and working the place try to make a support for me and my three Daughters living with me namely Adaline Sarah Ann Caroline and Easter Ann Elizabeth and so long as I may live each year after a support is made and provided for his family and mine that he receive one-half the surplus made on the place

Item second - It is my Will and desire that all my just debts be paid

Item third - It is my desire that my body be buried in a decent manner at New Bethel Church by the side of my Daughter Angelina

Item fourth - I Will and bequeath to my Son Henry Solomon and my three Daughters Adaline Sarah Ann Caroline and Easter Ann Elizabeth, have all my property both real and personal to share equally in dividing said property and if any one of the above mentioned children should die without marrying and leaving lawful heirs the survivors to share their part equally

Item Fifth I do hereby appoint my friends Andrew E Jarver and Eldridge Page my Executors of this my last Will and Testament

Item 4th The residue of my Negros after deducting the Three Thousand
 Dollars Worth above Specified to my Daughter Julia Ann, together with
 all my remaining Property including Stock of all kinds Money
 I Give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Mary, and to all of my Children
 Excepting my daughter Julia Ann to be divided Equally Among them

Executed this the Twenty Ninth day of January in the Year of our
 Lord one Thousand Eight hundred and Sixty one.

Signed and sealed in the Presence of three Witnesses the day and date
 above Written. I desire that my Daughter Julia Ann to have in
 addition to the Three Thousand Dollars before mentioned an Equal Share of
 Stock and I Give and bequeath the same to her.

Item 5th I direct that my Grand son Stephen J Sanders share
 Equally with my Daughter whose names are not here written

Item 6th the Negroes that I have heretofore given off to my Children
 are not included in this Testament
