Item 4^d: It is my will and desire that each of my children upon their arrival
at the age of (21) twenty one, to receive from my estate the sum of
One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) in cash.

Item 5^d: It is my will and desire, that should my wife die leaving no child
by me, that my estate shall be equally divided among the children of
C. Brighton, J. H. Brighton and Gertrude A. Gallagher; that is to say, the children
of each my brothers and sister to receive one third of my estate.

Item 6^d: I nominate and appoint my wife as the executrix of this my last will
and it is my desire and request that in the management and disposition
of my estate, she shall advise and consult with my brothers B. C. and J. H.
Brighton and my brother in law W. A. Gallagher and act for the best interest
of all the beneficiaries herein named.

Item 7^d: Upon the death or intermarriage of my wife I nominate and choose
