20^r of Mar I Isham H Saffold of Green Hill in the County Washington County and State aforesaid being of sound mind and disposing memory publish and declare this as my last Will and testament,

My Estate real and personal is to be kept together and my wife is to have the use and enjoyment of the same during her life, At her death Thomas P Saffold of the County of Morgan and George Jordan of the County of Milwaukee are to divide my property of every kind into two equal parts keeping my negroes as much as possible with their families.

When my estate shall be so divided Thomas P Saffold is to take one half and George Jordan the other half, each to have and to hold his respective share for the benefit of the relatives and kindred of myself and wife, That is Thomas P Saffold is to give to my relatives and George Jordan to the relatives of my wife as the judgment of each shall dictate &c

I appoint Thomas P Saffold of the County of Morgan and George Jordan of the County of Milwaukee Executors to this my last Will and testament with full power to carry out the same without being accountable in the premises to any Court or legal process whatsoever

A Codicil to the preceding Will made as follows
