In the name of God Amen
I Jane Killingsworth of the County and State
aforesaid, knowing that all flesh must die and feeling
from my advanced age and bodily infirmity that my
time must soon be ended, and now being of sound mind
and disposing memory do make this my last Will and
testament, hereby revoking all other Wills heretofore made
by me

1st I desire that my body may be buried in a Christian
like manner suited to my circumstances and Condition
in life.

2^d I desire and direct that all my just debts and
funeral expences shall be first paid

3^d I desire and hereby give to my Grand Son James
K Kindman all the interest that I have in a County
land warrant that I am now applying for for services
rendered by my deceased husband John Philip, and also
the further sum of fifty Dollars, and I do hereby ratify
and confirm a deed of gift made by me to my deceased
son Knudrick Kindman of the tract of land whereon I now
live to his three children viz Levi M, Elizabeth and James
K Kindman

4th I desire and hereby give to each one of the Children
of my deceased Daughter Cindy Kinn twenty five Dollars

5th I desire and hereby give to my Grand Sons Jeremiah
Dixon Aaron Dixon and Knudman Dixon to each one fifty
Dollars

6th It is my Will and desire that my Executor hereinafter
named shall sell my five negro Slaves viz Mary Edmon
Clery and her two girl children without separating Clery
and her children, and all other property left by me
without being required to obtain leave from the Court of Ori-
mary to do so, and after paying the debts and legacies
specified in the above items, then the balance or remainder
to be equally divided between my two Daughters Fanny
W or wife of Henry Wood, Lucina Smith, widow of Henry
Smith, and the Children of my deceased Daughter Zeph-
who was the wife of Owen Jey Share and share alike

7th I do hereby appoint Samuel Robison and Henry M
Executors to this my last Will and testament
