Item 1st I give devise and bequeath to Sharon Warthen, the one half of my entire property and estate in addition to the property given him by deed dated 14th November 1869 which is recorded.

Item 2nd I give devise and bequeath to my nephew Stephen A. Hitchcock the other half of my entire property and estate.

Item 3rd I hereby constitute Sharon Warthen Executor of the property herein given to my said nephew Stephen A. Hitchcock he hold and manage the same for the benefit of said Stephen until he shall become of age - then to be turned over to him - and as my property consists mainly of one fourth interest in the co-partnership business of J. Warthen & Co. in mills land and mercantile business which is now in a sound and prosperous condition I devise and bequeath that it will be continued at least until the said Stephen A. Hitchcock shall become of age - hereby authorizing and empowering the said Sharon Warthen trustee for said Stephen to unite with the other partners in the sale or purchase of any lands or other property, in the transaction of the business without the delay trouble and expense of obtaining an order or decree of any Court or of administering.

Item 4th I hereby constitute and appoint Sharon Warthen Executor of this my last Will and Testament.
