State of Georgia } In the Name of God Amen: I Jonathan Gladdin
 Washington County } being of sound and disposing mind and memory and
 Considering the uncertainty of this mortal life do make and declare
 this my last will & Testament in manner and form following
 per I wish all of my just debts properly satisfied

2nd It is my wish that the church at Smyrna shall have a lot of
 land commencing at the black barn corner and running to the road
 in front of the church and from thence said road to the head of a certain
 gully near said road thence down said gully so as to include the
 spring now used by the church thence up the line to the said B gun
 corner & give bequeath and devise said lot to the church so long as it is
 used by the whites for a missionary Baptist Church I also give and
 bequeath for the use of burial ground one fourth of an acre which
 shall include the grounds near said church as a family burying
 ground. I give bequeath and devise to my wife (Lydia Gladdin) all of my
 estate both real and personal after all my debts of my lawful and just
 debts are satisfied during her widowhood and then at her death or mar-
 riage all the property to be sold and equally divided among the heirs of the
 aforesaid Lydia Gladdin's body and to their heirs and successors forever

I hereby constitute and appoint my friends G W Gladdin & Lee &
 Gladdin Executors and my beloved wife Lydia Gladdin Executrix of this
 my last will and testament hereby revoking all others heretofore
 made by me said Executors and Executrix to hold for the benefit of the
 heirs of my sons William R Gladdin and Jonathan R Gladdin their
 distributive share of money from my estate till each of them shall
 become of age by law.
