1<sup>st</sup> I wish all my relatives well and hope they may prosper in this world and at last be prepared for immortal bliss.

2. I command my soul to him who gave it.

3. I wish all my property at my death to go to my beloved mother Mary Holmes, for her to have and hold during her natural life; but at her death I wish it to be equally divided between my surviving Brothers. To make this third clause unmistakeable it is my intention to give to my two Brothers a simple title to all my Estate after my mother's life ~~estate~~ shall have expired, I mean my two Brothers now living George Holmes and William Holmes, but if either of them shall die before my mother Mary Holmes, then for it all to go to the one then living at her death this thirteenth day of October One thousand eight hundred and sixty two, and in the year of our Lord

In the name of God Amen

I Jordan Holmes, of the County and State aforesaid, being about to depart to the service of my Country from whence I may never return, do make and ordain the following to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form following to wit

Item first My Will is, that all my just debts be paid out of my property that is not herein bequeathed to my Mother.

Item second - I give and bequeath to my beloved Mother Mary Holmes one Negroe boy by the name of Wright about ten years old to her and her heirs and assigns forever,

Item third I Will and bequeath to my beloved wife Sarah Jane Holmes all the rest of my property both real and personal, after the payment of my just debts to her and her heirs and assigns forever in full simple.

Item fourth, I do hereby nominate and appoint my Uncle Shadrack Wood Executor to this my last will and testament, ratifying and confirming the same by these presents,

In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal

this 12 day of May 1862
