I, Lewis A. Holt being of sound and disposing mind and memory, and knowing that I must at some time depart this life, do make this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking, admitting and setting aside all other Wills, Testaments made by me, and declare this to be my last Will and Testament.

I recommend my Soul to God who gave it, and my body to the earth by my Executors pious in such manner as they may think.

Ist It is my will and desire that all my just debts be paid together with my funeral expenses.

I^{2d} It is my will and desire and so direct, that all of my property of every description shall remain with and at the control of my wife, Sally to be used by her at her own discretion for her own Comfort and Convenience, during her natural life or widowhood, and after her death or marriage, that the whole of my estate both real and personal shall be equally divided between my four Children or their representatives viz. Benjamin W. Holt, Mary P. Smith, Rebecca C. Holt wife of A. C. Haines, Mary P. Acant wife of Wm. Acant, and in the event that my wife should again marry then and in that case she is to have an equal share with the Children share and share alike, and that portion of my estate that is hereby set apart for my daughter Rebecca C. wife of A. C. Haines, I do hereby give to Alvin C. Haines in trust for my said daughter Rebecca C. and the children of her body. Nothing in the Ist section is to be so construed as to allow the widow to sell or dispose of the property, she is to have a full and comfortable maintenance.

I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint William H. Acant my Executor to take my last Will and Testament.
