4th I desire that my land be not sold, but if my Executor in his judgement ascertain from his examination of my affairs that some of my land have to be sold to pay my debts, I wish him to use his discretion in selling off such personal and perishable property as can be best spared, and that will best promote the interest of my estate.

aforesaid, being about to leave home for the Confederate service, and knowing the uncertainty of life, deem it right and proper that I should make a disposition of the property with which a kind Providence has blessed me, do therefore make this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all others heretofore made by me.

Item 1st I desire that all my just debt be paid without delay by my Executor herein after appointed

Item 2nd I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Ann S Joiner and my five children Mary Frances, William B. Marion, Adress and Alaudra Joiner, to be kept together for the joint use and benefit of my said Wife and Children until the youngest child arrives at the age of twenty one year, the following property to wit, the plantation on which I now reside containing two hundred acres more or less, adjoining land of William Taylor & William S Collins four head of Negroes, head of Cattle, forty six head of Hogs, the provisions and

the plantation Household and Kitchen furniture and plantation tools, and I desire and direct, that upon the arrival of my son Alaudus, at the age of twenty one years, that all the aforesaid property and its increase be sold by my Executors and the proceeds arising from said sale be equally divided between my aforesaid wife and children or the survivors of them share and share alike.

Item 3^d I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife Ann J. and my son William B Joiner Executors and Executor of this my last Will and Testament. This August 4th 1863, under the advice and consent of my friends Susan Dudley and John Bell.
