I, Martha E Duggan of the County and State aforesaid, known that all must die, and desiring to make some disposition of my worldly goods, do hereby make this my last Will and Testament

First: I desire that my body be decently buried.

Second: I desire that all my just debts be paid, as soon as can conveniently be done.

Third: I give and bequeath to my daughter Pearl A Duggan, all my property, both real and personal to be held in trust for her by her father John E Duggan (whom I hereby appoint her Trustee) All the income arising from said property to be used for the comfort and support of said Pearl E Duggan during her life and at her death the property to be divided among the heirs of her body. Should my daughter Pearl E Duggan obtain majority and die childless, she may will the said property as she pleases; but should she die during minority without issue, then all said property to go to her father. My will and desire is, that my husband John E Duggan, the father and Trustee of said Pearl E Duggan, use not only the income of said property but also such part of the corpus of the property as he may think best for the education, support, dressing and boarding for said Pearl E Duggan during her minority. I also hereby authorize said John E Duggan, Trustee to invest or reinvest at any time, any or all the property of said Pearl E Duggan as he may think best.

I hereby appoint my husband John E Duggan Executor of this my last Will and Testament.
