And I do hereby, constitute make and ordain my friends William P Taylor and my son Robert Price my sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament, Ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last Will & Testament.

Martha Strange's Will

State of Georgia
Washington County In the name of God Amen

I Martha Strange of the County and State aforesaid being of sound disposing mind and memory and knowing that it is appointed for all persons once to die and bring clusions of making a disposition of my worldly estate do hereby Ordain publish and declare this to be my last will and testament in manner and form following:

Item 1^o It is my will and desire that all my just debts be paid first.

Item 2^o It is my will and desire that my negroes be divided in three equal shares One share to my Daughter Mary Hall and her children the present wife of Rubin A Hall

Item 3^o I give one thing to my four Grand Children to wit Sarah & Davis wife of Joseph S Davis, Martha A Roberts, John D Roberts and Theodosia Roberts children of my Daughter Martha A Roberts deceased,

Item 4^o I give to my Sons John S Strange and Richard A Strange in trust for my Daughter Emily S Adams Childton the remaining third of my negroes property to remain in the hand of the said John S and Richard A Strange to be kept home and until the youngest child becomes of age, then to be equally divided between Emily & Richard's children share and share alike

Item 5^o It is my will and desire that all my personal estate

property Household and Kitchen furniture to be sold and the proceeds divided in three equal shares, in the same like manner as stated in the 2nd, 3rd and 4th Items.

Item 6 It is my Will and desire that one third of the money arising from the sale of the plowable property with the money arising from the heirs of the negroes, that I give to to my Daughter Emily A Raines Children to kept at interest until the youngest child becomes of age by the aforesaid John & Richard D Strange, then to be equally divided and share and share alike between said children.

Item 7 It is my Will and desire that John & Richard D Strange be trustees for my Grand Children, Martha A Roberts, John R Roberts, and Theodora Roberts, until they become of age or marry. Item 8 I do hereby appoint John D Strange and Richard D Strange Executors of this my last Will and Testament.
