Taylor and my son Robert Price my sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament, Ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last Will & Testament.

Martha Strange's Will

State of Georgia
Washington County } In the name of God Amen,

I Martha Strange of the County and State aforesaid, being of sound disposing mind and memory, and knowing that it is appointed for all persons once to die, and being desirous of making a disposition of my worldly Estate do hereby Ordain publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form following.

Item 1st It is my Will and desire that all my just debts be paid first.

Item 2nd It is my Will and desire that my negroes be divided in three equal shares, one share to my Daughter Mary Ann Wall and her children the present wife of Reuben A Wall.

Item 3rd I give one third to my four Grand Children to wit Sarah & Dora wife of Joseph G Davis, Matthew & Roberts, John B Roberts, and Theodotia Roberts Children of my Daughter Martha P Roberts deceased.

Item 4th I give to my Sons John S Strange and Richard A Strange in trust for my Daughter Emily P Adams Children the remaining third of my negroes property, to remain in the hands of the said John S and Richard A Strange to be kept alive until the youngest Child becomes of age, then to be equally divided between Emily & Adams Children share and share alike.

Item 5th It is my Will and desire that all my personal

property Household and Kitchen furniture be sold and the proceeds divided in three equal Shares in the same like manner as stated in the 3rd 3rd and 4th Item,

Item 6 It is my Will and desire that one third of the money arising from the sale of the perishable property with the money coming from the hire of the negroes that I give to to my Daughter Emily & Rainers Children be kept at interest until the youngest Child becomes of age by the aforesaid John S. & Richard B. Strange the whole is equally divided and share and share alike between said Children

Item 7 It is my Will and desire that John S. & Richard B. Strange be trustees for my Grand Children, Martha A. Roberts, John B. Roberts, and Theodora Roberts until they become of age or marry

Item 8 I do hereby appoint John B. Strange and Theodora B. Strange Executors of this my last Will and testament
