Washington County } In the name of God Amen I Matthew Durden of Said State and County being of advanced age but of sound and disposing mind and memory, knowing that I must shortly depart this life, deem it right and proper, both as respects my family and myself that I should make a disposition of the property with which a kind providence has blessed me. I do therefore make this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and annulling all other by me heretofore made

First I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner suitable to my circumstances and condition in life. My Soul I trust shall return to rest with God who gave it. I hope for Salvation through the merits and atonements of the blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ

Secondly; I desire and direct that Archelus Dugan be paid one mole of cotton and that Casswell Smith be paid twenty one dollars and a half and that John F. Trout be paid twenty five dollars to be paid by my Executors herein after named and appointed

Thirdly; I give bequeath and devise to my beloved wife Sarah and her children in and to the behoof Consisting of Land Horses Cows Hogs and farming utensils Hens hold and children for and during her life time or widow hood or until the youngest one of her children be one become of age

Fourthly; I give to bequeath and devise to my son Lewis Durden one dollar

Fifthly I give bequeath and devise to my daughter Malinda Durden one dollar

Sixthly; I give bequeath and devise to my son Durden one dollar

Seventhly; I give bequeath and devise to my son William W Durden one dollar

Eighthly; I give bequeath and devise to my daughter Harriet Stone one dollar

Ninthly; I hereby constitute and appoint my wife Sarah and her Executors of this my last Will and Testament This September the 18<sup>th</sup> 1868
