

Nicajah Bland

In the name of God Amen, I Micajah Bland of the County of Washington and State of Georgia being of sound and disposing mind and memory do make constitute and Ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following to wit

Now, I give and bequeath to my Grandson Marshall W W Blunt the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to him and his heirs forever.

Item, I give and bequeath to my Daughter Nancy E Rainer, wife of Griffin Rainer, the sum of Five hundred Dollars to her sole and separate use, free from all Control and Management of said Griffin Rainer, her present Husband, or any future Husband the said Nancy E Rainer, may have to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give devise and bequeath to my daughter Minnie Hodges wife of John R. Hodges a tract of land lying on Buffalo Creek where the said John R. Hodges now lives, containing one hundred acres more or less, to her sole and separate use, free from the trouble or management of her present Husband the said John R. Hodges, or any future Husband she may have to her and her heirs forever.

Now, I give, devise and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Jane Kennedy wife of J. F. Kennedy a tract of land in the County of Westchester and State of New York, upon which the said J. F. Kennedy at present resides containing two hundred and two and a half acres to her sole and separate use free from the control or management of her present husband the said J. F. Kennedy or of any future husband she may have to her and her heirs forever.

Item It is my will and desire that the balance of my estate real and personal be sold for Cash, and that my Executors pay over to my wife, Elizabeth Bland, one fourth of the said estate, so sold which said one fourth I give and bequeath to my said wife Elizabeth Bland to her and her heirs forever, and the other three fourths I will in Sense be equally distributed among my children and Grandson H N Bland share and share alike under the same restrictions and limitations as are hereinbefore provided.

I hereby do appoint and constitute John R. Hodge, as Executor
to my last will and testament.
