11 Item - I hereby constitute and appoint my Son Oliver B. Braddy my Executor of this my last will and testament, this December 6th 1854

I Moore Price of the County and State aforesaid being well in body, health & of sound disposing mind & memory & calling to mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed unto men, once to die, do make and Ordain this my last will and testament - I recommend my soul into the hands of God that give it me & my body I recommend to the earth from whence it came to be buried in a decent and Christian like manner, at the discretion of my Executors as touching the worldly goods, wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life, after my just debts and funeral Expenses being first paid, I give and dispose of in the following manner & form to wit

Item 1st I give to my Son John Price the sum of one Dollar to him and his heirs forever

Item 2nd I give to my Daughter Nancy Price the sum of one Dollar to her & her heirs forever

Item 3rd My will and devise is that all the balance of my Estate both real and personal consisting of lands Horses Cattle Hogs

Moore Price, Will,

Sheep Household & Kitchen furniture together with every other individual thing that I may have or be in possession of at my death, or may properly, that may fall to me otherwise, be equally divided between my other eight children namely, Robert Price, William Price, Seaton Price, Anna Price, Elbert Price, Mary Ann Price, Sally Price & Elizabeth Price to them and their heirs forever. And if any of the above named eight children should die before they shall have lawfull heirs, then the property to be divided amongst those surviving of the eight above named children. And I do hereby constitute make and ordain my friend William P. Taylor and my son Robert Price my sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament, Ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last Will & Testament.

Martha Strange's Will

State of Georgia
Washington County } In the name of God Amen,

I Martha Strange of the County and State aforesaid, being of sound disposing mind and memory, and knowing that it is appointed for all persons meet to die, and being desirous of making a disposition of my worldly estate do hereby Ordain publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form following.

Item 1st It is my Will and desire that all my just debts be paid first.

Item 2nd It is my Will and desire that my negroes be divided in three equal shares, one share to my Daughter Mary Ann Hall and her children the present wife of Reuben A. Hall.

Item 3rd I give one third to my four Grand Children to wit Sarah L. Davis, wife of Joseph G. Davis, Martha A. Roberts, John B. Roberts, and Theodotus Roberts, Children of my Daughter Martha A. Roberts, deceased.

Item 4th I give to my Sons John S. Strange and Richard B. Strange in trust for my Daughter Emily S. Adams, Children the remaining third of my negroes property, to remain in the hand of the said John S. and Richard B. Strange to be kept until the youngest child becomes of age, then to be equally divided between Emily S. Adams, Children share and share alike.

Item 5th It is my Will and desire that all my personal
