I give bequeath and devise to my beloved son Samuel H Lang and my daughter Harriet C DeLoos, all of my estate both real and personal consisting of Real estate and personal estate in the City of Sandersville of said State and County and some wild lands in said State and all other property both real and personal, that I now have or may have at the time of my death to be equally divided between the said Samuel H Lang my son and the said Harriet C DeLoos my daughter, to their own proper use benefit and behoof forever; with full power to dispose of the same as they may see proper.

Fourthly. I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved son Samuel H Lang Executor of this my Last Will and Testament.
