After the execution of the aforesaid, should I have any other property with which I have dealt, at the time of my death, I direct that it be equally divided or sold and the proceeds be as equal shares as provided for by execution of my will made in the 3rd of May 1841, that is to say each of my sons having a share and the children of my deceased daughter having the share which their mother would be entitled to were that living

Item Eighth. I constitute and appoint John son James having full power, full power and authority to do all things that may be necessary and proper to do in and about the execution of the aforesaid will and to hold the same for them until their arrival of age.

Item Ninth. I hereby constitute and appoint my two sons Zachariah F. Hall and James F. Hall Executors of this my last will and Testament.
