I Reuben Underwood of said County and State being in good body, health and of sound and disposing mind and memory do make this my last Will and Testament

First I bequeath my body to the earth to be buried in decent and respectable manner, and my Soul to God Almighty

Second - I give devise and bequeath after all of my just debt shall have been first paid by my Executors unto Ernoch T. Miller my Grand son, all my property and estate real and personal and mixed, and in remainder expectancy or reversion of which I shall be possessed or to which I shall have the right of possession or property at the time of my death, in trust nevertheless for my Daughter Sarah the wife of Isaac T. Miller, for and during the term of her natural life, during this time she is to have the use, profits, rents and proffits of the said property in such manner as I now enjoy and use the same, but not to dispose of the same in such manner as to prejudice the right of those who shall have the remainder after the particular life estate and after her life is determined and at her death, the said property is to go to and be divided among her children as shall be alive at the time of her death and the representatives of those who may have and provided that at that time, such representatives, share and share alike to the children per capita and to the representatives per stirpes. The true intent and meaning of this bequest and devise, being to give to my said daughter a life estate and remainder to her children and the representation of her children as may be alive at the time of the death of my said Daughter to be divided as aforesaid

Third I enjoin upon all whom it may concern to take notice that this is my true last Will and Testament, and hope and require that no one shall attempt to break it. And I do hereby appoint and constitute my Grand son Ernoch T. Miller and my friend John D. Wright as Executors to this my last Will and Testament and do hereby Sign Seal declare publish and publish this my last Will and Testament, and as such to be known receive respected and acted upon, this eighth day of April in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and forty seven
