Washington County } In the name of God Amen

I Richard Watters advanced in age weak in body, sound in mind, knowing I must shortly depart this world, it is right that I shoul make a disposition of the property which a kind Providence has blessed me with, I therefore make and declare this to be my last Will and Testament. I hereby revoking all other Wills that I may at any other time have made. I desire my body to be buried in a Christian Manner. My soul I trust will return to God who gave it, As I hope for eternal Salvation through the blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ whom religion I have professed, and I believe and humbly trust enjoyed forty three years.

I desire that all my just debts be paid without delay by my Executors

First divide I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Margarette Watters for and during her natural life, the Plantation and all the land belonging to it, on which I now live together with all my plantation tools also all my House hold and Kitchen furniture, also all my Hogs Sheep Hens Mules and Cattle, Carriage Cars, and Wagons, also all the provisions Corn fodder and grain and all the Crop that may be growing on my Plantation at my death or so much as she may see fit to take, also six Negro slaves, Jim Margarette and her child Sam, young Mannie Horner and Olick and their spouse, I also give my wife Margarette Negro woman old Maria to dispose of at her death, as she pleases, after the death of my wife Margarette Watters the plantation with the plantation tools, Hogs Sheep Hens, Mules, Cattle all the works

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and Kitchen furniture the provisions of all kind, the grazing Crop and
every and all things that may be on the Plantation at the death of my
Wife except the negroes he will also all the land I own in the Counties of
Lawrence Emanuel and Montgomery he sold at the death of my Wife
to the best possible advantage, but the Money arising from the sale of
said property at the death of my Wife Margaret Watters be equally
divided between my following Children, Alice M'London formerly Alice
Watters, Thomas Watters, Simon Watters, Seaborn Watters, Gandy Webb,
Formerly Watters, and Richard B G Watters, and go to them for and during
their natural lives, and at their death to their lawfull children. The portion
of the Money going to Thomas Watters shall be held in trust by Simon
Watters and Richard B G Watters or either of them as trustees for Thomas
Watters and the interest or profits arising from said Money to be annually
used for the support of Thomas Watters and his family not to be subject
to the debt, Contracts or Conflicts of the said Thomas Watters, and the portion
of Money going to Alice M'London shall be held in trust by Simon
Watters and Richard B G Watters or either of them as trustees for Alice
M'London, and the interest or profits arising from said Money to be
annually used for the support of Alice M'London and her children, said
Money and income is not to be subject to the debt, Contracts or conflicts
of her Husband Barnet M'London or any other future Husband. The
money or portion going to Gandy Webb, is to be held in trust by Simon
Watters and Richard B G Watters or either of them as trustees for said
Gandy Webb. The interest or income arising from her portion is annually
to be used for her children and Husband support. Should the said Mrs.
Webb die leaving no children, then her share or portion is to go to and be
equally divided between Alice M'London, Simon Watters, Thomas Watters
Seaborn Watters and Richard B G Watters, for and during their
natural lives and at their death to their lawfull children.

Second Divide. I give and bequeath to my son Richard B G Watters
after the death of my Wife Margaret Watters, the following named
negro Slaves Jim, Margin Ann and her child Jim and young
Moriah and their increase for and during her natural life and at his
death to go to his lawfull children, in case he leaves no lawfull
children but leave a widow. She is to have the use of said property
for and during her widowhood or natural life, after marriage or death
the property is to go to and become the property of Alice M'London, Thomas
Watters, Simon Watters, Seaborn Watters, Gandy Webb, and to be
equally divided between them for and during their natural lives, and
at their death to their lawfull children. The portion that would go
to Alice M'London, and Thomas Watters and Gandy Webb, to be held in
trust and disposed of in the same way as the property that goes to
them after the death of my Wife Margaret Watters mentioned in the
first Divide. The portion that would go to Alice M'London and
Thomas Watters from Gandy Webb, mentioned in the first division
and the portion going to them and Gandy Webb from Richard B G Watters
property, shall be held in trust and disposed of in the same manner
their portion is held and disposed of at the death of my Wife Margaret

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Walters mentioned in the first devise.

Third Devise I give and bequeath to my son Simon Walters at my death my negro man Slave named Hermit for and during his natural life, at his death to his lawful children.

Fourth Devise I give and bequeath to my son Leuton Walters after the death of my wife Margaritt Walters the negro man Slave named Ellick for and during his natural life, at his death to his lawfull children.

Fifth Devise I give and bequeath unto my daughter Alice M'London wife of Burwell M'London, the following named negro Slaves, Dorcas, Andrew Little Charity and Scott together with their increase for and during her natural life and at her death to her lawfull children to be held in trust by Simon Walters and Richard B G Walters or either of them as trustees, for said Alice M'London The profits arising from said negroes to be used for the support of Alice M'London and her children and the said negroes and their increase and profits not to be subject to the debts Contracts or Controll of her Husband Burwell M'London neither subject to any other Husband she may have.

Sixth Devise I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Walker, wife of Gott Walker for and during her natural life and at her death to her lawfull children, the following named negro Slaves, Charlotte and her two children George & Abram and Daniel, I bequeath to my Daughter Mary Walker for and during her natural life at her death to her lawfull children after the death of my wife Margaritt Walters the sum of five hundred dollars, and she has no further claim in and to my estate.

Seventh Devise I give and bequeath unto my Son Thomas Walters for and during his natural life and at his death to his lawfull children the following named negroes Slaves Johnson, Freeman and Dick, also the land in which he now lives containing four hundred acres more or less lying in Lawrence Emanuel and Montgomery Counties said land and negro slaves to held in trust by Simon Walters and Richard B G Walters as trustees for Thomas Walters, the proceeds arising from said land and negroes to be annually used for the support of Thomas Walters and his family said land and negroes and the profits arising from this is not to be subject to the debts Contracts or Controll of Thomas Walters.

Eighth Devise I give and bequeath to my daughter Gadsy Webb wife of John A Webb, for and during her natural life and at her death to her lawfull children the following named negro slaves Peety Crawford Mahaley and Elbert, and their increase, Should Gadsy Webb die and leave no lawfull children, the said negroes negroes to go and become the property of Alice M'London Thomas Walters Simon Walters Salem Walters and Richard B G Walters, for and during their natural lives and at their deaths to their lawfull children, The portion that will go to Thomas Walters and Alice M'London is to be held and disposed in the same way as the property is to be held and disposed of after the death of my wife and Richard B G Walters as mentioned in the first and second devise.

Ninth Devise I give and bequeath to my daughter Margaret A Jones for and during her natural life at her death to her lawfull children the following named negroes Slaves, Party Ann Hammock and Minkie and their

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increase and the following amount of money at the death of my wife Margaret Walters the sum of Seven hundred Dollars and she has no further slaves in my estate.

Fourth Division I give and bequeath to my son Seaborn Walters for and during his natural life and at his death to his lawfull children Sarah and Jeremiah and their increase.

Fifth Division I give and bequeath unto my Son Simon Walters for and during his natural life and at his to his lawfull children the following named negro Slaves, Abby and Leah and their increase.

Sixth Division My negro man Henry and his wife Rachel is not to be separated and is to go and become the property of one of my children such one only as I may select and the one, that takes Henry is to pay for Henry and Rachel such sum of Money as three diminutives may say Henry and Wife Rachel is worth and the Money with the interest to be put with the money arising from the sale of the property after the death of my Wife Margaret Walters and be disposed of as part and parcel of said Money.

The negro Slaves I give to my daughter Elizabeth named Dorcas Little Charity, Anna and Scott together with their increase in case she dies leaving no lawfull children to revert to and become the property and be equally divided between Thomas Walters, Simon Walters, Seaborn Walters, George Webb and Richard B. G. Walters for and during their natural lives, at their death to their lawfull children, The portion that would go to Thomas Walters and George Webb shall be held and disposed of for them as their portion is held and disposed of in the first Division after the death of my Wife Margaret Walters and it done in the second Division after the death of Richard B. G. Walters. If Henry Allenden dies leaving no lawfull children then his portion to be disposed of the same as is dispose of his mother Alice Allenden died leaving no lawfull children.

I hereby appoint and constitute my Son Simon and Richard B. G. Walters my Executors to this my last Will and testament dated this 23rd day of August 1854.
