" 2nd I will and bequeath all my Estate both real and personal (with such reservations as I sh all hereafter make, of every kind whatsoever to my sister Elizabeth T Smith during her natural life, free from any present and future liability of her present or any future husband, and at her death to the children of her body begotten forever in fee simple, reserving to my Father Bennett Crafton an usufructuary use of said Estate during his natural life

3rd I will and bequeath to my niece Jane Gilman Smith Daughter of Dr James B Smith, the following property to wit
I nominate Eldridge C Williamson Executor to this my last Will and Testament

In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my seal and acknowledge this as my Will, dated this the 9th day of January 1854, S. B. Crafton Seal
