I Simeon Bland of said State and County being of advanced age and knowing that I must shortly depart this life deem it right and proper both as respects my family and myself, that I should make a disposition of the property which a kind Providence has blessed me, wherefore make this my last Will and Testament.

1<sup>st</sup> Item, I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner suitable to my circumstances and condition in life. My soul I trust shall return to rest with God who gave it, as I hope for eternal salvation through the merits and attainment of the blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ whom Religion I have believed in for the last thirty five years.

2<sup>nd</sup> Item, I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without delay by my Executors hereinafter appointed as I am unwilling my Creditors should be delayed in their rights especially as there is no necessity for delay.

3<sup>rd</sup> Item I give and bequeath and direct to my daughter Jane Cox Elizabeth Wood and Sarah Ann Five hundred Dollars apiece which is to be paid unto them out of the Sale of my Land and Stock.

4<sup>th</sup> Item I desire and direct that all my Land and Stock be sold.

5<sup>th</sup> Item I desire and bequeath unto the Orphans of Mary Shippard deceased an equal share in my Estate to be distributed to them as they become of age in money and I appoint my Brother and Trusty Son William H. Bland Trustee of the property given over and bequeathed to the Orphan children of Mary Shippard deceased.

6<sup>th</sup> Item I desire and direct my Executors to divide my Slave property into equal lots as near as possible to be divided equally among my five Sons Henry McCaughan H. William H. Reuben H. and W. B. Bland and my two Daughters Jane Cox and Sarah Ann Bland.

7<sup>th</sup> Item I desire and direct all my Household and Kitchen furniture sold.

8<sup>th</sup> Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Wood an equal share in the sale of my Land and Stock Household and Kitchen Furniture.

9<sup>th</sup> Item I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved Sons William H. and Reuben H. Bland Executors to this my last Will and Testament this May 20<sup>th</sup> 1862. Simeon Bland 82<sup>7</sup>
