In the name of God Amen,
I Solomon Gladen of the County and State aforesaid being in an
advanced age, and knowing that it was appointed by God all men to
die, desiring to arrange my Temporal matters while I have time and
opportunity, do therefore make this my last Will and Testament hereby
revoking all others heretofore made by me.

First, It is my Will and desire that my body after my death be
buried in a decent and Christian like manner and that my Executors
shall and burial expences, be paid as soon as practicable.

Second— It is my Will and desire that my Son Benjamin Gladen
inherit all my land except fifty acres more or less, which I give and
bequeath to my Daughter Nancy Gladen, beginning at a Court
Sum Corner on my said land, and William S. Mansbros land, running
thence a direct line to the back of my Horse lot, thence through the
pavage of my present dwelling House to the right of the grave yard
Corner to the old calf pasture to a pine, thence along an old crop
fence to the corner of said fence, thence a direct to the Branch, thence
along said Branch to the beginning Corner.

Third I will and desire that my Daughter Nancy Gladen
occupy the old room of my present dwelling House in her right.

Fourth, I desire and will that if my said Daughter Nancy
Gladen desires to sell her fifty acres of land given to her by this
Will, that she sell it to no person except my Son Benjamin Gladen
at a reasonable price or common price for land, and if my Daughter
Nancy Gladen dies leaving no lawful heirs this said fifty acres
tract of land is to belong to my Son Benjamin Gladen, and I
hereby appoint him Benjamin Gladen agent or trustee for Nancy
Gladen.

Fifth I will and desire that my Son Benjamin Gladen and my
Daughter Nancy Gladen have equal share in my Work Week to buy
and to use it in the plantation.

Sixth I will and give to my Son Benjamin Gladen and my
Daughter Nancy Gladen three Cows and six yearlings to be equally
divided between them, I also will to my Daughter Nancy Gladen
two sows and piggs and three sheats.

Seventh, I will and desire that my Daughter Julia Ann Gladen have
ten Dollars paid to her in Cash by my Executors.

Eighth I will and desire that my Daughter Nancy Ann Gladen
have five Dollars paid to her in Cash by my Executors.

Ninth I do hereby nominate and appoint my Son Benjamin Gladen
Executor and my Daughter Nancy Gladen Executor to carry out the
provisions of this my last Will and Testament. hereby revoking all other
will by me made, this 12th day of December 1868.
