

# Solomon Newsome

State of Georgia In the name of God Amherst  
 Washington County Solomon Newsome of the State and  
 County above mentioned being of sound and disposing mind  
 and memory and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs  
 while I have strength to do so do make and publish this  
 my last will and testament hereby revoking all wills by  
 me at any time heretofore made. First first I commit  
 my soul to God who gave it and my body I desire to be  
 buried in a decent and Christian like manner, and my  
 worldly estate I dispose of as follows.

Article 1<sup>st</sup> I desire that my belived offences and all of  
 my just debts be paid as soon as possible after my death

Article 2<sup>d</sup> I now bequeath and devide to my beloved Sons  
 Nathan & Newson and Jessie & Newson all that  
 tract or parcel of land situate and lying lying on the waters  
 of Ogeechee River containing Twenty four hundred and thirty  
 four ~~acres~~ (2434) more or less adjoining lands of Middle  
 the Estate of Daniel Morris Esq; Jr & others known  
 as the Satts Plantation also all the stock farming utensils  
 and appurtenances there on

Article 3<sup>rd</sup> I now bequeath and devide to my beloved  
 Daughter Eliza S. Newsome and my beloved Wife Eliza  
 Newsome during her natural life and at her death all  
 to my Daughter Eliza S. Newsome all that tract or parcel  
 of Land situate and lying on the Ogeechee River adjoining  
 Lands of Heth & Upson & Elam S. Mullig Bennett Heth Esq; does  
 the same in lot of S W Greene & others containing Sixteen acre  
 and one eightea acres more or less known as the home place  
 together with all the stock farming utensils and appurtenances  
 thereon also any other lands money notes and accounts that  
 may belong to me at my death all that is contained in the  
 Article 3<sup>rd</sup> will bequeath and devide to my Daughter Eliza S.  
 Newsome and my Wife Eliza Newsome during her natural life  
 then to my Daughter Eliza S. Newsome for her own separate use  
 and benefit free from the debts or liabilities of my husband  
 that she may thereby retaining the privilege of choosing her  
 own trustee

Article 4<sup>th</sup> I hereby appoint my worthy and beloved Sons Nathan  
 & Newson and Jessie B. Newsom Executors to this my last will and  
 testament

Article 5<sup>th</sup> It is my desire that should my Daughter Eliza S. New-  
 son get married before the death of my beloved Wife Eliza  
 Newsome and the husband of my Daughter Eliza S. Newsom should  
 mistreat or disagree with my Wife Eliza Newsome then it shall  
 be the duty of executors to divorce legally the parties left them

to return it to my Daughter Eliza B. Newson in the same  
manner as first stated in article the third  
In witness whereof the said Solomon Newson to this my  
Will consisting of the foregoing three Sheets of paper have sett my  
hand and seal, this the 26<sup>th</sup> day of November A.D. 1868.
