2nd I desire that all my just debts be paid without delay
by Executors hereinafter written and appointed
3rd I desire that my husband Elijah Eastwood have the use of
my plantation the present year 1877 for his own proper use and
support and behoof forever with full power to dispose of in his will
as he may deem proper

4th My Land that Judge J. S. Youngblood now holds in trust for
me I want sold and the proceeds of the same to be applied to the
purpose of procuring Mises John Stone to be placed at my

if then any be left I want applied to putting the same
of my father and mother in a good & substantial condition.

5th The remainder of my estate I desire that my hus-
band have for his own property ^{and} he hold during his life time to be
distributed out by my executors as he may wish it among his heirs.
And at his death what may then be left I desire that it be equally
divided between the heirs of my estate ^{and} the estate of my husband

6th All of my stoves household ^{and} kitchen furniture I desire
that it remain with my husband during his life time for his
own use and at his death it be disposed of as ^{my husband} shall think in solicitor of
this will.

7th I cannot but appoint my friends John J. Youngblood ^{and}
Augustus A. Clummet executors of this my last will ^{and} testament
