I Stephen Mills being of sound mind and
 disposing memory and knowing the Uncertainty of human life, do make
 the following disposition of all of my Estate both real and Personal, as follows
 namely as my last Will and Testament-

Item 1st I give and bequeath to my four Sons viz James W.
 John F. Stephen B. and Solomon L. Mills all of my Land Except
 what I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Mary, to share Equally with

Item 2nd To my Wife Mary I give and bequeath of my Land
 an Equal share With my Sons

Item 3rd to my dear daughter Julia Ann I give and bequeath
 Negroes to the Amount of Three Thousand Dollars

Item 4th The residue of my Negroes after deducting the three thousand
 Dollars worth above specified to my daughter Julia Ann, together with
 all my remaining Property including Stock of all kinds Money
 I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Mary, and to all of my Children
 Excepting my daughter Julia Ann to be divided Equally Among them

Executed this the Twenty Ninth day of January in the Year of our
 Lord one thousand Eight hundred and Sixty one.

Signed and sealed in the Presence of three Witnesses the day and date
 above written. I desire that my daughter Julia Ann to have in
 addition to the three thousand Dollars before mentioned an Equal share of
 Stock and I give and bequeath the same to her.

Item 5th I direct that my grand son Stephen J. Sanders share
 Equally with my daughters whose names are not here written

Item 6th the Negroes that I have heretofore given off to my Children
 are not included in this Testament
