I Thomas H Brown of the County and State aforesaid, being low in health but of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make and Ordain the following to be my last Will and Testament, as follows to wit

Item 1st I give bequeath and devise unto my brother Lewis H Brown all of my right title and interest in the underland tract of land in said County in the action of William Swamp adjoining lands of the Estate of John Kittrell and others whom my Father Handley Brown died, the interest in said land I hold may be seen by reference to the last Will and Testament of the said Handley Brown Also my Horse and Buggy to my said Brother Lewis H. to him and his heirs forever

Item 2^d I give bequeath and devise to my two youngest Brothers George and Alexander Brown all of my interest in and to Eleven negro Slaves to wit Sarah a woman, Hannah a woman, Margaret a woman and her infant child Mitchell, Virginia a girl, Jack a boy, Sam a boy, Dayman a boy, Melu a Boy, and Laura a girl. My interest in the said negroes being one third of which negroes are now in the hands and possession of Lewis H Brown as Guardian of myself and two youngest Brothers named in this Item, To them the said George and Alexander Brown their heirs and assigns forever
