together until my youngest child comes of age.

Item fourth. When my youngest comes of age I want my Estate to be
equally divided between my beloved wife and children.

Item fifth. I constitute and appoint my beloved wife Martha Executive
and my two sons Charles A. and George W. Moyer and Major G. Wood
Executors to this my Will and to sumit this October 30th 1857.
