Given the sale of property herein directed to be sold be insufficient to pay the full amount of each bequest they are to be paid in proportion to the amount collected.

Item 20 It is my desire and wish that the bequests by me in property shall not be interpreted with otherwise than to be applied to the purposes specified.

Item 21 My Will and desire is that one acre of the tract of land known as the Hopson tract shall be reserved in the sale of the said land by my Executor including the burying ground and that my Executor who have that part occupied by graves inclose with a suitable brick Wall and gate suited to the work.

Item 22, I constitute and appoint my friend Richard Northern Executor to this my last Will and Testament this the twenty fourth day of October 1846

Item 2: It is my Will and desire and I do hereby bequeath the whole of my Estate both real and personal unto my beloved Brother Thomas Jordan and beloved Son Archibald Jordan in trust for the use and comfort of my beloved Wife Phoebe Jordan during her natural life not subject to the Controul of any future Husband she may marry, but he is to exclusively apply to the support of her and her minor children born unto me, but

but should there be any surplus or surplus of my Estate personal Estate over and above what my beloved Wife Phoebe may require for her support as above mentioned I hereby cloath her said husband by and with her consent to pay or deliver to the one of my Children standing mostly in need, and take his or her receipt for the same, which shall stand in that much of and in his or her proportion of my Estate at a final distribution of the same which I wish and desire to be done as soon as practicable after the death of my beloved Wife and distributed according to law among all my Children or their legal representatives, share and share alike - Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my beloved Brother Thomas Jordan and my beloved son Archibald Jordan Executors to this my last Will and Testament
