I William A. Morgan of Said State and County being of sound &
disposing Mind & Memory do make & ordain this to be my last will &
Testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me made
Item 1^o I direct that my remains be buried in a decent &
Christian like manner suitable to my circumstances in life
Item 2 - I have recently sold to John F. Tanner forty one acres
of Land lying near Paris Mill and joining Isaac Tanner, Jesse
Brown & others for the sum of Five hundred & Twenty dollars
He has paid me on this purchase one hundred dollars & has furnished
to me about Twenty thousand Dollars which are to be estimated and
credited on this purchase at a reasonable valuation Now if the said
John F. Tanner shall pay the balance of the purchase Money of this Land
within a reasonable time then my executors are hereby instructed to execute
to him a sufficient deed to the same Item 3^o I give to my Daughter
Annie Heattie Morgan one share in the Central Rail Road Stock
Item 4^o I also give to my said Daughter Annie Heattie the sum of
Fifteen hundred dollars (\$1500) which sum is to be raised for her
from sale of personal property & by collections of notes & accounts
but if the same cannot be otherwise provided for it shall be
raised by sale of land Item 5^o All the rest & residue of my
property of every description whether real or personal I want held
& kept together for the mutual support & benefit of my wife Anna
Hodges Morgan & my said Daughter Annie Heattie Morgan until
the my said Daughter arrives at age, or marries, then said property to be
equally divided between my said wife and daughter provided that if
my said Daughter shall die without child or representative of
children then all the property given to her in this item as well as
all other property given to her by this Will shall go to and become
the property of my brother James M. Morgan or if he be dead then
to his children Item 6^o I constitute & appoint my wife Guardian
of the person and property of my daughter Annie Heattie Item 7^o I
appoint my wife Annie Hodges Morgan & my friend John Whetstone
Executive & Executor of this my will
