Zachariah H. Roughton

Georgia Washington County In the name of God Amen:

I Zachariah H. Roughton being of sound and disposing mind and memory and recognizing the awful fact that I in common with my fellow man must die when in the good Providence of God Almighty He shall see fit to summon me. And being desirous of arranging my business in this world before my departure for the next. Do make and publish this my last will and testament hereby revoking all other wills heretofore made by me -

Item 1<sup>st</sup> I do hereby will and direct that my body be received that good decent and Christian burial suitable to my means, and my faith and belief in the immortality of the soul through our blessed savior neither pompous nor extravagant but plain and conformable to my circumstances in life -

Item 2<sup>d</sup> I do hereby direct and will that my honest debts be paid in full -

Item 3<sup>rd</sup> I give and bequeath the balance of my entire estate, both real and personal to my wife Sarah A. H. Roughton during her life or widowhood - to sit and ride during her life or widowhood as she pleases that is to say that she may sell or otherwise dispose of any part or the whole of the said estate or change the investments when and how she pleases. After her death or on her intermarriage then the said estate to pass to my children C. A. Roughton, Bradford E. Roughton, Hodges & Hollington Mary her trustee Roughton & H. Roughton junior Richard D. Bynum Roughton and Gainer Roughton share and share alike -

Item 4<sup>th</sup> I do hereby will and direct that in the event my said wife Sarah shall die or intermarry before my son Gainer shall have received an education similar to that received by my other children then and in that event he is to, and I hereby will that he shall receive from the corpus of my estate as a special legacy over and above his distributive share of the estate and independent of it the sum of one thousand dollars -

Item 5<sup>th</sup> I will and bequeath to my children aforementioned to wit: C. A. Roughton - Bradford & - Hodges & H. - Zachariah H. Mary Letitia Richard P. B and Gainer - upon the death or intermarriage of my said wife and after the legacy to my son Gainer mentioned in Item 4 the my entire estate both real and personal share and share alike

Item 6<sup>th</sup> I do hereby nominate and appoint my wife Sarah A. to the executors of this my last will;

Item 7<sup>th</sup> I do also appoint my wife Sarah A. guardian of my minor children! This February 27<sup>th</sup> 1876

give any of the property hereby bequeathed to her to any of our Daughters I
